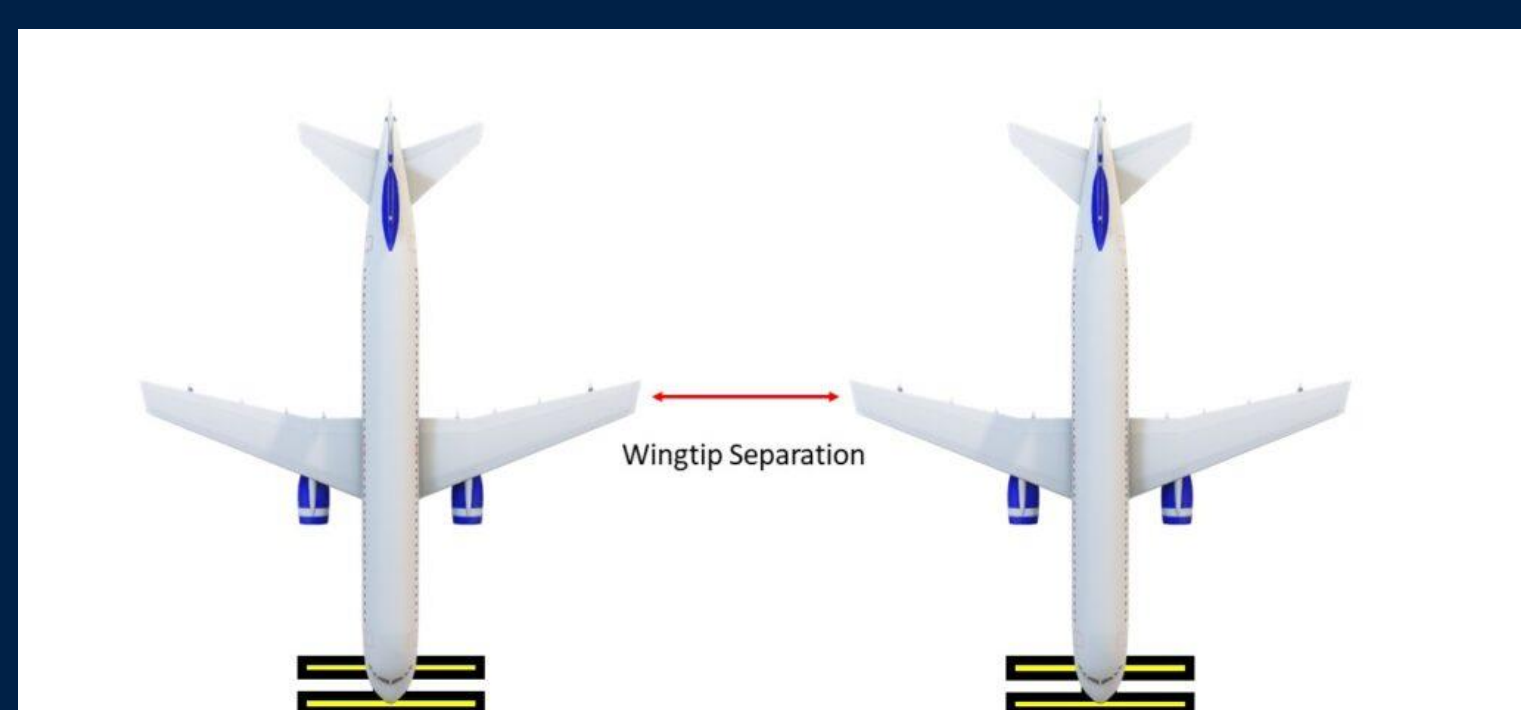


Is the aircraft stand clear
whilst an aircraft is
entering or exiting the
stand?

No GSE, vehicles, personnel or obstacles must be within the stand footprint during an aircraft arriving or departing the stand.

Aircraft clearance and separation distances are different for each aircraft variant. It is the aircraft marshal's responsibility to ensure these clearances are achieved. If ever in doubt, STOP the aircraft and remove the obstacle prior to resuming marshalling the aircraft onto stand.



The following minimum clearances between an aircraft entering or exiting the stand and any adjacent building, aircraft on another stand and other objects must be achieved.
