
The HMRC app is secure, quick and easy to use.

If you have a Government Gateway account, sign in here.



Once open, the HMRC app will show your personalised 'Money' screen.

You should then tap on the Pay As You Earn (PAYE) section.



# Summary of steps to take

- 1. Download or open the HMRC app from Google play, or the App Store
- 2. Create a Government Gateway account, or log into the HMRC app if you've already signed up
- 3. Once open, the app will show your personalised 'Money' screen tap the Pay As You Earn (PAYE) section
- 4. Tap on the arrow next to 'Your employment and pensions for this year and past years'
- 5. You will see 'Your PAYE Income Tax History'. You can scroll down to see the five previous years
