



Check the height of your  
vehicle or towed equipment  
before use!

Where vehicles or equipment have raised platforms, lifts and surfaces that can be extended, ensure all surfaces are retracted before transit.

There are many vertical clearance hazards within the airside environment that require added situational awareness whilst using high sided vehicles or equipment that may have extendable raised surfaces.

Always ensure equipment or extendable ancillaries on vehicles that can be extended are retracted whilst in use and be vigilant of vertical hazards.

Ground clearance hazards can be;

- Aircraft flight control surfaces.
- Infrastructure – buildings, gate bridges etc.
- Other equipment or vehicles that may have overhanging surfaces.

Prescribed heights of vertical/ground clearance can be found in the manufactures Airplane Characteristics manuals for aircraft specific models and AOI 12 – Control of Vehicles for infrastructural height restrictions.
