Manchester Airport

- Huge asset for Greater Manchester and the wider north of England
- Private car is the current default choice for travel to the airport
- Work together to make public transport and active travel the easy, reliable and obvious choices
- Rail services to the airport have been too unreliable for too long. Need to work with TOCs and DfT to support reinstatement of services
- Already working with MAG on how we signpost visitors to our public transport services and lobbying Government for future investment
- Work together to support future recruitment and employee travel behaviour




Metrolink Airport Line

- Opened in 2014, with almost 3.5 million users in 2018/19
- Provides connectivity between Airport and city centre but also between the Airport and surrounding communities, unlocking employment opportunities
- New line has improved airport access for the local community. 24% of Wythenshawe residents surveyed use the tram to get to the airport
