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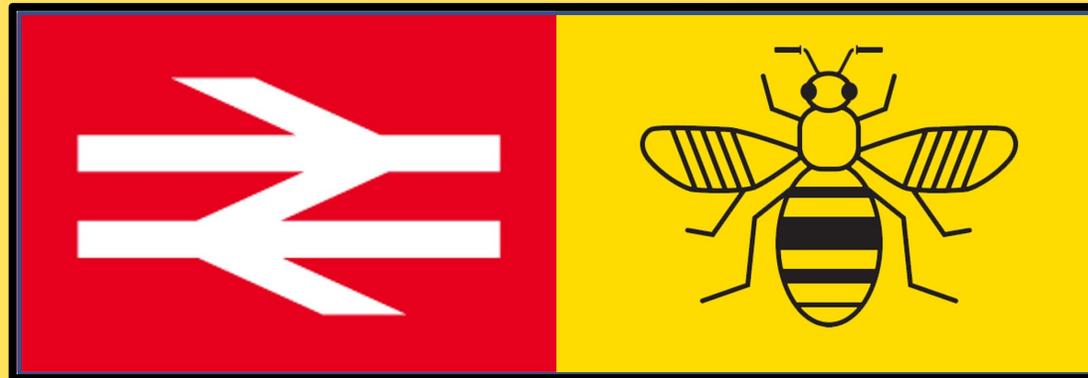

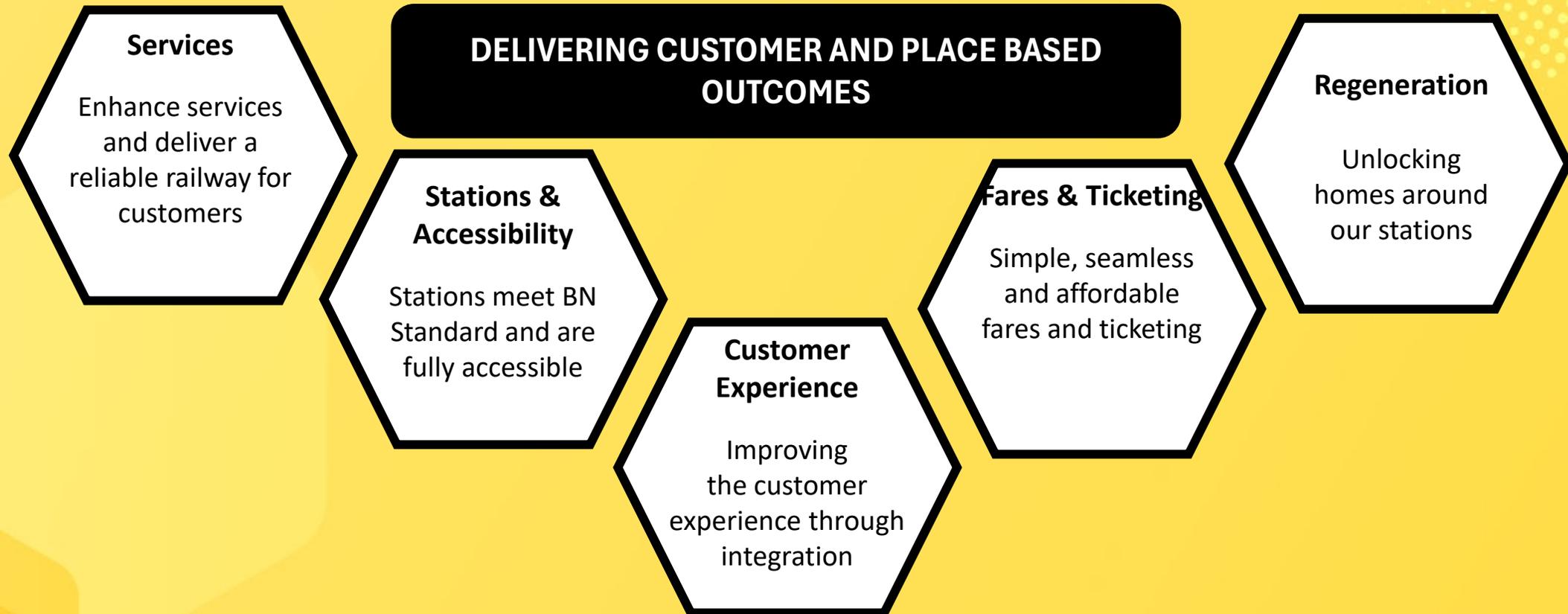

## Outcomes: Growing the Network

# Fares made simple

## Bus: simple

Single fare*	£2 adult
1-day Bee Bus ticket	£5 adult
7-day Bee Bus ticket	£20 adult
28-day Bee Bus ticket	£80 adult
Annual Adult Bee Bus ticket	£800

## Rail: complex

<b>Advance Single</b>	£2.50 – £35.90 £16.80 – £31.20
<b>Off-Peak Single</b>	£19.70 – £31.20
<b>7-Day Season</b>	£58.90 – £81.50
<b>Anytime Return</b>	£63.40 – £85.70 £106.80
<b>Annual Season</b>	£2,780 – £3,970

## Rail: made simple



# Fares made simple: what does it mean for customers

## Simpler travel decisions:

Customers no longer need to worry about which operator they are using or whether a return is better value.

There will simply be one fare per journey.



## Cheaper single fares:

More than half of journeys (52%) will become cheaper, as many single fares are reduced to half the cost of a return.

## Lower average fares:

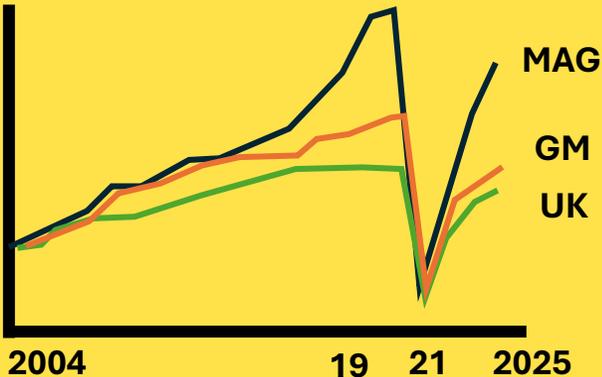
The change will mean that the average fare in Greater Manchester will fall by 5.6%.

## Better flexibility:

Passengers travelling out during peak hours but returning off-peak will only pay for the cheaper leg not a peak return.

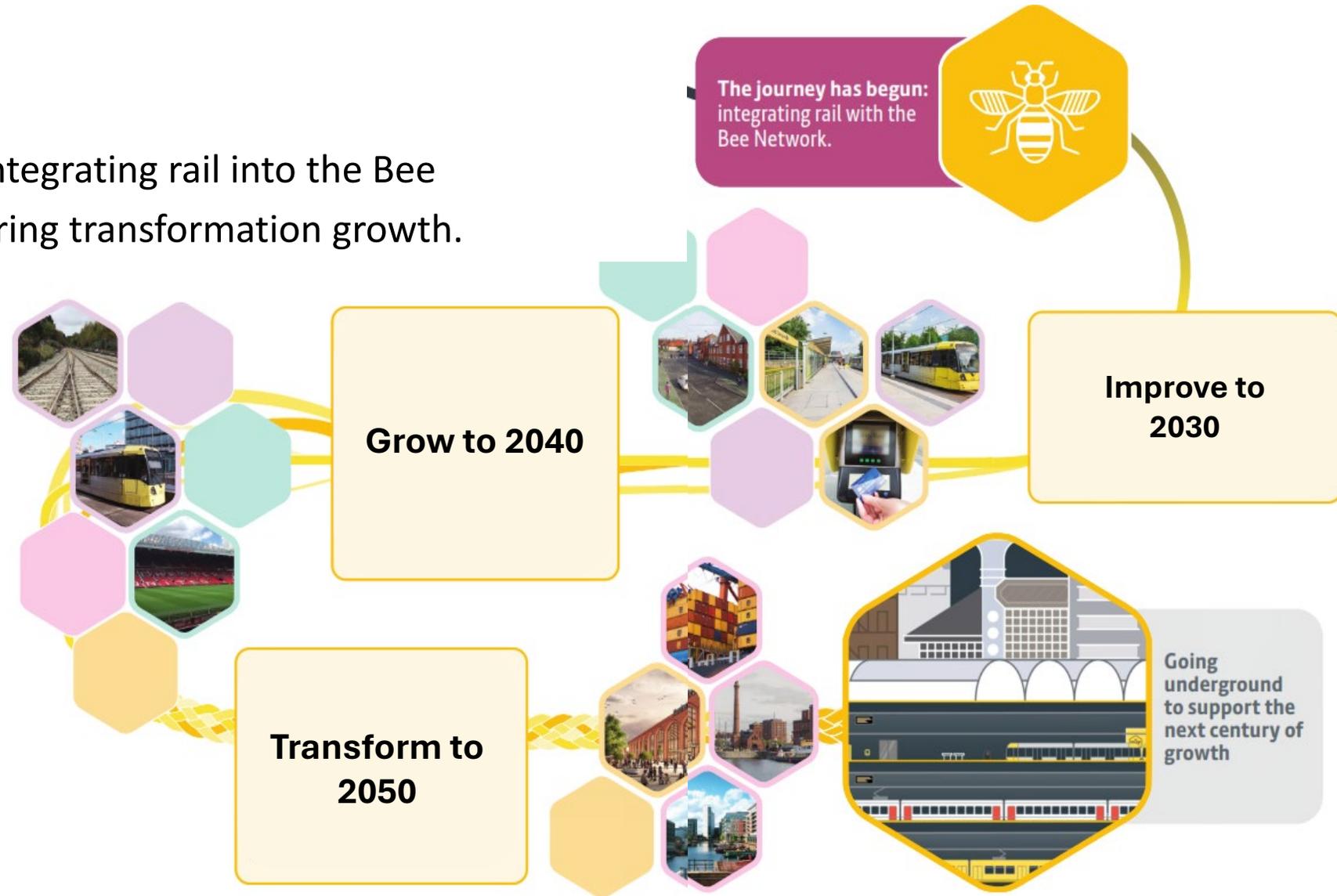
