**Hold Short of
Aircraft Marshals**



Never Drive Behind an Aircraft Marshal

- When aircraft marshals have engaged marshalling signals with aircraft, never drive behind a marshal.
- Continue to hold short of aircraft marshals until the marshal has lowered their wands or gives you the all clear to proceed.
- Depending on the aircraft type and stand configuration, marshals may need to position themselves in the head of stand road.
