Different travel modes are available to get to the airport. Choices are made on the grounds of:














Surface access relies on a range of transport providers

"Reliability of public transport"








2 - CAA passenger survey - modal share

fairly stable, 51-60%

17-21%, declining since Q4/2019

7-10%, declining since Q2/2019

1-3%, slow decline from Q1/2020

15-20%, slowly recovering to pre-2020 levels

- Reviewed the staff survey results and the updated action plan arising from the Travel Plan.
- Top 10 interventions are being assessed to identify how and when they might be introduced.
- Additional Local Link vehicle launched 31 July, with extended service area.
- New starters can benefit from 4 weeks free travel with Stagecoach Bus or Metrolink.
